In some batches of Fraké, black lines and an absence of pinholes, give this type of wood an even more striking and characterful appearance. Fraké is a firm and resistant wood type that is extremely well suited to a variety of applications, including cladding and frame wood. The wood can be easily applied and ages beautifully and evenly.
