

Platowood Fraké

Fraké is a fast-growing hardwood species, originating from responsibly managed forests in West Africa. These forests are OLB-certified and sustainably managed. Sustainable forest management means a responsible and nature-based way of harvesting, in which the preservation of the forest is not endangered.

Consideration is given to biodiversity, the working conditions of forest workers and the rights of forest inhabitants. Platowood attaches great importance to these social and ecological aspects. To monitor these aspects Platowood visits the sawmills itself to purchase the wood.

Platowood Fraké has a sleek, stylish and exotic appearance. The wood surface has a flame-like pattern that is further accentuated by platonising (hydro-thermal modification).

Technical information

Wood is a natural product. Fraké contains characteristic wood properties, such as pinholes, knots and bariolé (mineral streaks). These properties give the wood a distinctive appearance. Platowood Fraké is a strong and impact-resistant wood species that is highly suitable for various applications, such as cladding and window, frame and door wood. The wood can be used untreated and will weather over time due to exposure to the elements.
