

Platowood Spruce

Platowood Spruce originates from responsibly managed forests in Northern Europe. This fast-growing softwood species is FSC and PEFC certified.

Spruce is traditionally used in the Netherlands in structural work, but through the unique refining process of Platowood (platonising) the wood is transformed into a high-quality wood species with high durability and very good dimensional stability. The whitish-yellow natural colour of spruce wood is exchanged during platonising for an attractive brown colour. A large stock of Platowood Spruce is available as standard!

Technical information

Characteristic for Platowood Spruce is the presence of knots, which may contain a crack or star. Furthermore, resin pockets are allowed, as well as other smaller patterns in the wood. All these features give Platowood Spruce a lively and natural appearance. The wood, if left untreated, will weather evenly.

Platowood wood by default meets European fire class D-s2, d0. When the wood is treated with the fire-retardant Bio FireProtect, European fire class B-s2, d0 can be achieved.
